Congratulations on your UG Admission to GMC, Nagarkurnool.

What to do next?

Step 1: Click on the "MBBS ADMISSION CHECKLIST" in [UG Admissions - GMC Nagarkurnool](#) webpage.

Step 2: Go to any National bank (example: SBI) prepare the following DDs

- A) D.D. amount of Rs.29000/- (OC & BC) and Rs.27000/- (SC & ST) in favour of Principal CDS GMC NGKL
- B) D.D in favor of "THE REGISTRAR, KNRUHS, WARANGAL" Fee Rs. 12000/- For (All India Quota Students)

Step 3: Prepare Non-Judicial Stamp Papers. Format is available in the required document check list link.

(Non Judicial stamp paper can be purchased in any state/district in India)

- A) Undertaking Bond for Rs. 20 Lakhs on Rs:100 Non-Judicial stamp paper
- B) Anti-Ragging Bond by Student on Rs: 100 Non-Judicial stamp paper
- C) Anti-Ragging Bond by Parent on Rs:100 Non-Judicial stamp paper

Step 4: With all the documents in the checklist present yourself in the college. College timings are 9:00am to 4:00pm.

## **FAQs:**

Where to buy Non-Judicial Stamp paper?

Non Judicial stamp paper can be purchased in any state/district in India.

The content to be printed on the non-judicial stamp paper is available in the required document check list link.

What is Study & Conduct certificate?

Certificate provided by school and intermediate college after completion of 10th and intermediate examinations respectively. In some schools it is also known as "Bonafide certificate".

What is equivalence certificate?

This certificate is needed only for All-India category students. In other words, students who completed intermediate outside of Telangana state can apply for "Equivalence certificate" with the Telangana State Board of Education.

What is Migration Certificate?

This certificate is provided by the Intermediate college after completion of 12th examination.

What about hostel fee?

Details of the hostel fee will be provided at the time of hostel admissions.
